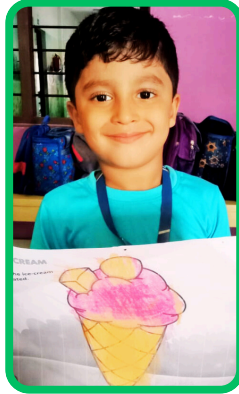

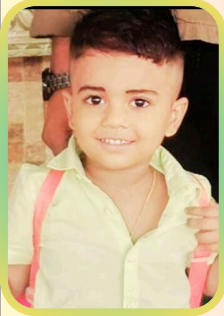

-- Interactive sessions encouraged citizens to share their experiences and suggestions regarding corruption prevention.



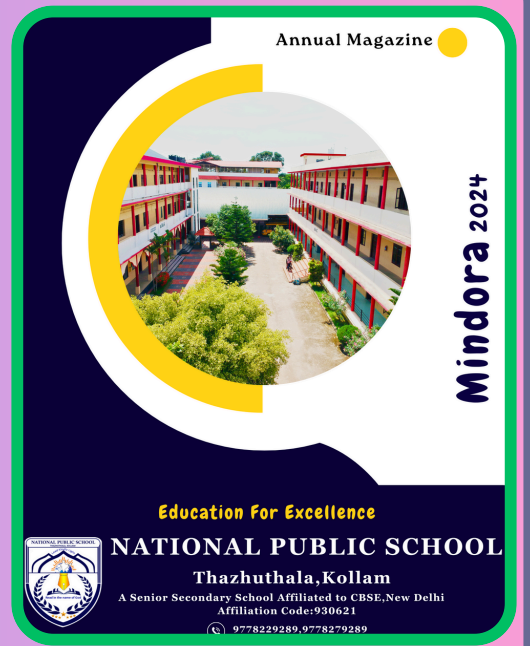
