Awareness Session on POCSO, Cyber Laws, and Traffic Laws

On 22/11/2024, Friday an awareness session was conducted at NPS to educate students about the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, cyber laws, and traffic laws. The session was organized by the Kollam District Legal Service Authority in collaboration with Kottiyam Pauravedhi. The primary objective was to raise awareness among students about their rights, legal protections, and responsibilities as citizens. Mrs Jisha Mukundan, secretary & Sub Judge, District Legal Service Authority officially inaugurated the session where Dr KK Shajahan, Chairman, NPS delivered the presidential address in the benign presence of Mr Niyas A, Sub Inspector, Cyber Police Station, Kollam, Mr Nazim Sain, Principal NPS and Mrs Subina Sudheer Sudheer , Vice Principal, NPS.

Smt Jisha Mukundan, Sub Judge from the Kollam District Legal Service Authority delivered engaging thoughts on the above mentioned topics where she focussed the provisions of the POCSO Act, highlighting reporting mechanisms and the importance of vigilance against child exploitation. The session unfolded the information on POCSO Act and its importance in protecting children from sexual offenses, about cyber laws to ensure responsible internet use and online safety and to be edified with traffic laws, emphasizing road safety and responsible behavior as pedestrians and future drivers.

An interactive session with Mr Niyas A, Sub Inspector, Cyber Police Station, Kollam sow seeds of newfangled infos on legal protections and online behavior, safe internet practices, encompassing passwords, recognizing phishing attempts, and understanding privacy settings on social media. Real-life scenarios were discussed by Mr Niyas A , S I to illustrate potential online threats and how to respond effectively.

The importance of adhering to traffic laws too was emphasized, focusing on pedestrian safety and the role of cyclists. It was an engaging session while he fostered a culture of road safety among young individuals. Frangance on how to be brave regarding resources on how to seek help and report crimes were being shared for further guidance. In collaboration with Kollam District Legal Service Authority and Kottiyam Pauravedhi proved effective in reaching the youth and instilling a sense of legal literacy.

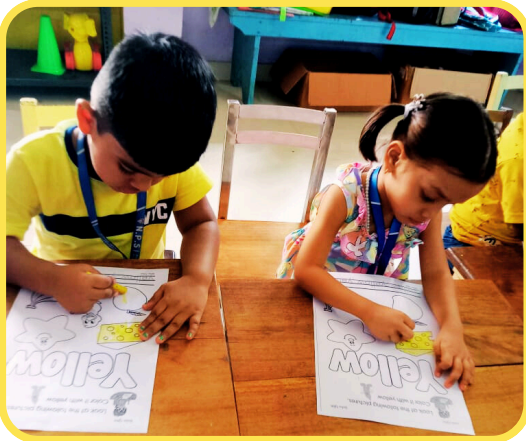

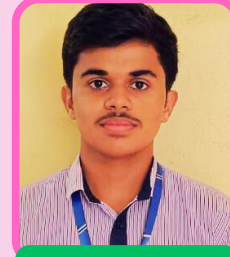

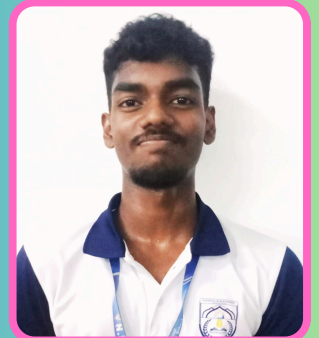
